HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.

Storage. Supplies of food and bedding must be stored in a manner that protects the supplies from spoilage, contamination, and vermin infestation. The supplies must be stored off the floor and away from the walls, to allow cleaning underneath and around the supplies.

There is spilled feed on the floor and boxes on one pallet are against the wall in Cooler 2 in Central Receiving . All spilled feed needs to be removed from the floor to prevent a pest problem and food supplies stored away from the walls of the cooler to allow for cleaning around the supplies.

Main Chimp Building: There are bags of cabbage stored on the floor of the cooler in the central kitchen . These bags need to be placed on pallets to prevent contamination of the cabbage.

All of the above items were corrected during inspection .
